SAFETY INFORMATION FOR EASTER TRAILS.

PLEASE READ THIS INFORMATION BEFORE STARTING THE TRAIL

As there are uneven and unlit footpaths, we strongly advise doing the trails in daylight.

Walk in groups of no more than 6 including children

Ensure a responsible adult leads each group as children or vulnerable adults should not be unaccompanied

Keep socially distanced from other groups

Adults are advised to wear face coverings when other groups are at the same location

Maps must not be shared with other groups or returned afterwards

Walk on pavements or safe walking routes

3. What was the colour of the robe the soldiers put on Jesus?
4. What was the name of the garden where Jesus and his disciples prayed?

6. What was written on the cross above Jesus?
7. Who asked for the body of Jesus?
8. Who did Mary think Jesus was when she first saw him?
9. What did Jesus do with his disciples, after he rose from the dead?
